## **INTRODUCTION:**

Maria Lixian Gee-Schweiger, Ph.D., is the founder and president of the Chinese Writers Association of America and the World Micro Drama Research Association. Born in China, she immigrated to the U.S. in 1992 after working for 11 years as a screenwriter and editor at Heilongjiang TV in China. Dr. Gee-Schweiger has taught Chinese at American colleges for over two decades and has served as chairperson of the American Chinese Culture and Education Foundation and as a visiting professor at Jinan University in China. She has published seven books in the U.S., including The Restless Hearts, Viewpoints of Li Xian, The Hardship of Youth and Now, American Lawyers Speaking Chinese, Adrift Without Roots, The True Feeling About America, and Crossing the Half-Open Gate. Additionally, she directed and produced the documentary Adrift Without Roots and wrote the TV series Story of the Lawyer's Office. Dr. Gee-Schweiger has published nearly a hundred literary works across various genres in newspapers and magazines. Her extensive contributions have earned her fifteen awards, including the Asian Heritage Award in Media and Film in 2009.
